Some things are universal ... kids love having a visitor to their classroom, they love the educational puppets that the MDHA has available for doing presentations, they love getting a new toothbrush (so do the teachers!), and there will be kids with a story to tell about their teeth, dental experiences and completely unrelated topics during question time. And, nothing quite compares to getting a hug and hand coloured thank you cards from the kids.
